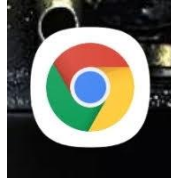
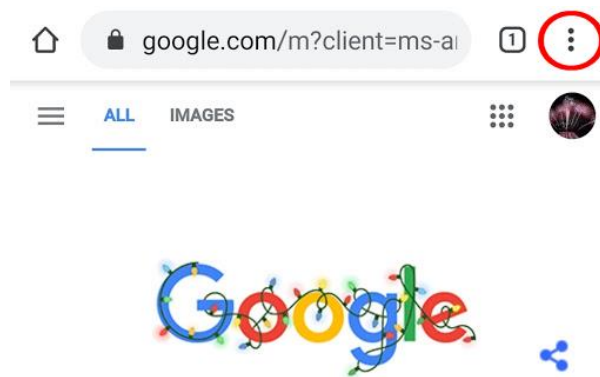


Allowing Pop-Ups in Google Chrome for Android devices

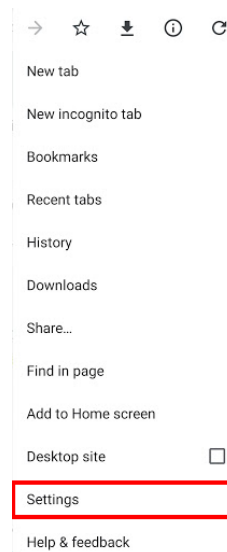
1. Open the Google Chrome app on your phone; the Chrome App should be installed by default on every Android device. The icon will look something like this:



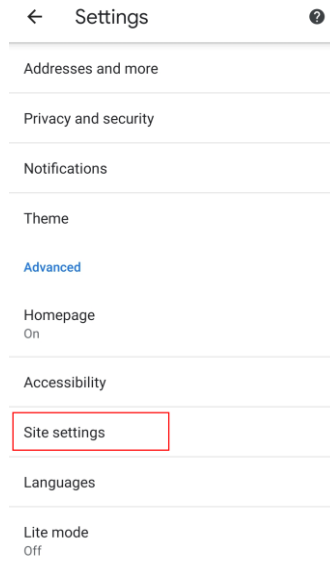
2. Tap the 3 dots circled in the image below to bring up a drop down menu. There may be an arrow instead of the 3 dots here – if there is, you may need to update your version of Google Chrome, which will also be an option in the menu that opens. We recommend always updating to the latest version.



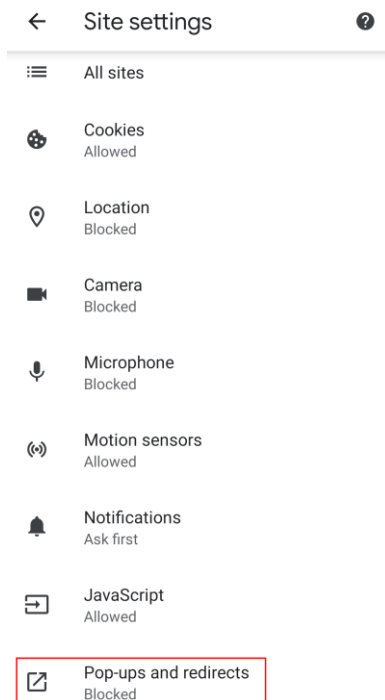
3. Tap Settings in the resulting menu that opens (Highlighted below)



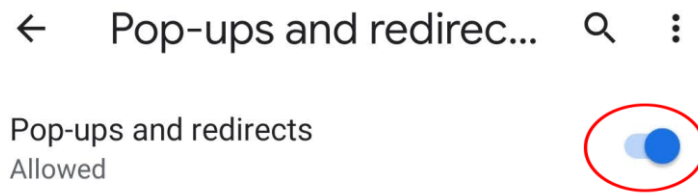
4. You will be in the Settings menu – scroll down until you see Site Settings and tap on that (highlighted below)



5. You will now be in the Site Settings menu – scroll down until you see Pop-ups and Redirects, and tap on that (highlighted below)



6. In the resulting Pop-ups and redirects menu, make sure the only setting is set to “Allowed” by flipping the toggle switch circled below.



After your visit, if you would like to block pop-ups and redirects again, you can follow this same guide up to step 6, and toggle the switch back to “blocked” instead of allowed.
